

Camp Cleanup Rules and Regulations

Check List

Kitchen

- Stove, including burners, grill, stainless steel behind stove, oven and grease trap cleaned.
- Stainless steel sinks and draining boards cleaned
- Stainless steel work tables cleaned
- Camp pots, pans, etc washed and put away
- Refrigerators cleaned out and wiped down
- Floors swept and mopped
- All left over food removed from camp
- All garbage/trash cans dumped and liners replaced with clean bags
- All garbage and trash are to be removed from camp at time of departure
- Clean sneeze guard

Main Hall

- All tables and chairs must be cleaned and returned to their original location
- Floor swept, mopped and any trash removed
- All garbage/trash cans dumped and liners replaced with clean bags

Restroom/Shower Rooms

- Toilet bowls cleaned with a brush
- Toilet lids and outsides cleaned
- Sinks cleaned
- Floors swept and mopped
- Shower rooms cleaned and bar soap removed
- All garbage/trash cans dumped and liners replaced with clean bags

Check List, (continued)

Cabins

- Floors swept and mopped
- All garbage/trash cans dumped and liners replaced with clean bags
- Mattress covers need to be wiped down with bleach water

Camp

- Camp policed and all trash picked up and disposed of
